We are enormously grateful to you for offering to support Lost Chord by providing a volunteer for our latest fundraising event, 'The Sheffield Jail Break'. We are progressing well with the event and as a result feel it necessary to update you on the arrangements which are in place for the day on Saturday 13th September.

A drinks reception has been arranged to be held at The BMW Garage Sytner on West Street Sheffield for 10.00am where the Chief Constable has arranged for an arresting officer to be present. After the reception at 10.30am all volunteers will be arrested and taken to the Crown Court.

At the entrance to the court you will pass through security and be taken to Court 1 by the usher where His Hon. Judge Murphy QC will be presiding.

Richard Sheldon Esq will be acting as the Counsel for the Prosecution and an indictment will be read out for each accused along with a short 'prosecution' case so that sentence can be passed.

Hopefully at this point you will be able to present bail of £1,000 and avoid being taken to the cells. However in the event that your bail falls short of the said amount you will be allowed to take your mobile phone with you to the cells in an attempt to raise the shortfall.

The whole proceedings will be conducted tongue in cheek and I'm sure that we will all have a very enjoyable time. Sentencing is due to start at 11.00am and the proceedings shouldn't take longer than an hour. Family and friends may care to give support from the public gallery. Please let me know if you will require any passes for the public gallery which can be acquired.
